2. For information regarding how to report or file a claim of discrimination, harassment, or retaliation, see the Richwoods R-VII Board of Education Regulation ACA. Policy and Regulation ACA shall govern the grievance procedures, process, and response for complaints and concerns by parents, patrons, employees, or students of the Richwoods R-VII School District related to discrimination, harassment, or retaliation on the basis of race, color, national origin, ancestry, religion, sex, disability, age, genetic information, or any other characteristic protected by law. Inquiries or concerns regarding civil rights compliance by school districts should be directed to the local school district’s Non-Discrimination and Title IX Coordinator.
3. The requirement not to discriminate extends to admission and employment.
